Alumni Eligibility Policy

King's College London alumni are eligible to access most of our services for two years (24 months) following their course completion date. Beyond this point, we are unable to provide other services.

Your course completion date can be found on your Degree Certificate or via <u>Student Services Online</u>

Alumni eligibility criteria

King's Careers & Employability is only funded and resourced to provide services for recent graduates, up to two years beyond the completion of their course.

You can find a full listing of services which can continue to be accessed by both recent alumni and those who completed their course more than two years ago at the end of this document.

If you are ineligible for our services, or a mid-career professional seeking advice, we would recommend the <u>Career Development Institute's Professional Register</u> where you can seek individual guidance support.

Please Note: Whilst graduates of all faculties are entitled to use our central services in accordance with this policy, King's Business School operates its own careers team and therefore specific services they provide may not be open to their graduates in the same fashion. Please confirm with <u>King's Business School</u> which localised services remain available to you.

Maintaining access to our support

Eligible alumni (up to 24 months) will need to have requested an alumni account or updated your settings to retain access King's CareerConnect. Visit <u>our website</u> for full details of how to do this.

You will need to also register on <u>King's Connect</u> from Alumni Relations to gain your digital Alumni Pass, which will be needed when attending any events with us in-person and to access King's campuses.

Confirming or verifying your degree with an employer or other university?

King's subscribes to the <u>Higher Education Degree Datacheck</u> (HEDD). This online service will allow your prospective employer to confirm your degree with King's.
