#### What experiences do you bring to research?

I have had multiple years of experience around autism and the impact on individuals at schools and other places.

What motivates your involvement in research? Exploring depression in neurodivergent people is a really important area of research that hasn't been looked at in depth before, especially with the incorporation of lived experience voices.

What are the limitations of traditional research? Traditional research has not been helpful for the communities that could have benefited from or learnt from it. It has perpetuated negative and hurtful stereotypes.

#### What motivates your involvement in research?


I am very passionate about working with people with lived experience through collaboration, kindness and mutual respect. I believe this is when research can be really empowering and transformative.

It can be quite unemotional, lack the complexity

and struggle to deal with nuance and ambiguity. At

evidence based.

#### What experiences do you bring to research?

I have experience in youth work, creative workshop facilitation, and conducting participatory research for social change. I also have lived experience of neurodivergence.

#### What motivates your involvement in research?

What are the limitations of traditional research?

It can sometimes inhibit innovation and the scope of possibility. Sometimes it leads to research that is not fully relevant to the people it's trying to reach.

What are the limitations of traditional research? Traditional research practice often focuses on the issues or problems in society without a focus on the strengths and assets of people and places.

What experiences do you bring to research?

I've been involved in many conversations between health professionals and service users to amplify seldom-heard voices.


What motivates your involvement in research?

What are the limitations of traditional research?
Women who are at greatest risk of experiencing poor outcomes or care have not always had the opportunity to contribute to research in ways that focus on their own priorities.

What experiences do you bring to research?

My own experience of conception, pregnancy, birth and maternity care. I also hear various stories from the community around the topic of maternity and maternity care.

What motivates your involvement in research?

I am trying to understand how the maternity care system works and contribute towards improving health services.

What are the limitations of traditional research?

I think the balance should shift in order to improve the communication and exchange between researchers, healthcare professionals and service users.
