

Center for Asia Pacific Strategy and Corbett Centre for Maritime Policy Studies (KCL) Conduct Forum on Asia Pacific Strategic Issues in ROK

On April 4th the Center for Asia Pacific Strategy and the Corbett Centre for Maritime Policy Studies organised and moderated a forum of high-level Republic of Korea academics and policy-makers, along with members of the UK Higher Command and Staff Course who were conducting their first ever Staff Ride to the ROK. The HCSC delegation was from the UK Defence Academy, to whom King's College London is a core academic provider. The forum was moderated by Mrs. Hee-Eun Kim, the CEO and President of CAPS and Professor Greg Kennedy, Director of the Corbett Centre at King's College London. The facilities were provided by the Korean National Defence University in Nonsan. The forum covered a wide range of topics that highlighted UK and ROK strategic perspectives and interests in the greater Asia Pacific region. It is hoped that this will be the first of many such forums facilitated by the Center for Asia Pacific Strategy and Corbett Centre partnership in support of the HCSC staff ride to the ROK, helping advance a greater understanding globally of the region's strategic condition.
