King's College London, Franklin-Wilkins Building is the building indicated 'A' in dark green on the map below. Further details and maps are available here:

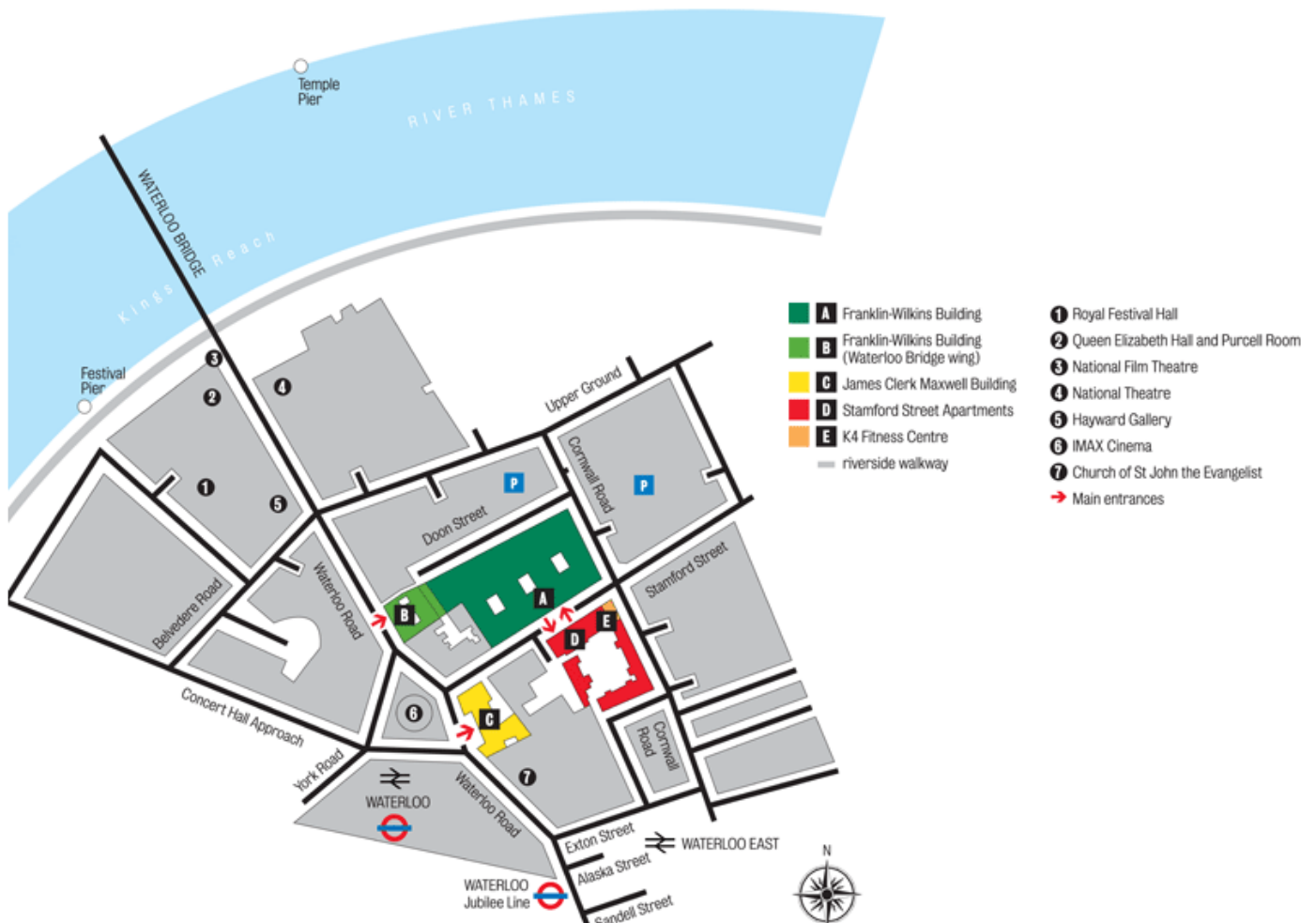

### Travelling to the Franklin Wilkins Building

**Underground:** Waterloo 4-minute walk (Bakerloo, Jubilee, Northern, Waterloo & City)

**Train:** Waterloo (4 minute walk), Waterloo East (5 min), Blackfriars (17 min).

When you arrive at the Franklin Wilkins Building please report to the Reception Desk at the entrance. You will need to show your invitation email to the security guards to show that you can access the building.



## Getting to the Department of Nutritional Sciences Metabolic Research Unit

- 1) Please arrive at least 5 minutes before your scheduled appointment time.
- 2) Once you are in the Franklin Wilkins Building, take the lift to the 4th floor. Please ask at the reception desk for directions to the lifts.

- 3) When you come out of the lifts, turn left, then walk 40 metres along the corridor.



- 4) You will arrive at the signs for Corridor A, turn left and you will see the entrance to the Metabolic Research Unit.
